Establishing Qualification and Ranking Systems



- 1. ICSD Congress in Vienna has approved Motions form Malaysia NDSF – We MUST establish it by the next Congress**
- 2. Many governments are unhappy with Deaflympics’s poor qualification or minimum timeframe system, and many governments say if no strong qualifying system made within ICSD, they will reduce their financial support**
- 3. The Executive Board approved in the Meeting in December 2022 that the ICSD Sport Directors must prepare in cooperation with the relevant International Sports Federation or, if applicable, the International Deaf Sports Federation, a proposal for the establishment of a qualification and ranking system in the respective sport**





Establishing Qualification and Ranking Systems



- 1. ICSD International Sports Director main task to contact with their Sport Directors and ISF (and if have, IDSF) for consulting it**
- 2. ISD contacted all SDs separately about this task (documents 30% finished)**
- 3. ISD to send the final proposal to ICSD EB for approval**
- 4. Next Congress will approve new qualification and ranking system with authorising EB for making changes if necessary with clear timeframe**
- 5. Communication with International Sport Federations for the MoU**

WC2.3. An ICSD member applying for the Deaf World Championships event must submit its application to the Secretariat at least two (2) years prior to the Championship and is subject to approval by the ICSD Executive Committee.

1. Closer communication with (national and) municipal sports/social administrations and the national federations of the relevant sports.
2. Preparation of a Memorandum of Understanding to be signed with the ICSD
3. Preparation of payment commitments to be signed by countries when accommodation is reserved.
4. Preparation for conducting hearing and doping tests.
5. Preparation for Social Media (Web site, Live broadcasting, etc.)
